Publication date: December 2007

This report will highlight successful strategies and cases studies in averting forced eviction and achieving secure tenure, including strategies that communities and organisations have used to halt or attain relief from forced evictions; strategies communities use to work constructively with governments; successful slum-upgrading projects, recent legal cases; and policies implemented by governments towards upholding the right to adequate housing.

The report will provide examples that can be used by communities, organisations, and all levels of government towards halting, preventing and remedying forced evictions.
