

JKKP 1996-2006. WHAT HAS BEEN DONE?

For almost one decade (1996-2006), JKPP focused its movement on the people organization strengthening program through participatory mapping. The program in a broad outline covered:

1. Improving the reaching capacity of the participatory mapping service

- 1.1. Through the development of JKPP participant's capacity. During this period, the activities conducted were: regional training on land participatory mapping, training of trainers on participatory mapping, training on Geographic Information System, training on Information System Development and training on participatory inventory.
- 1.2. Development of participatory mapping methodology. A manual on participatory mapping had been produced from the cooperation between JKPP and Alix Flavelle, as mandated in this program and the materials for training module on mapping.

2. Improving the quality of participatory mapping use

- 2.1. Policy Study. This program resulted in 4 times studies on landscape, i.e. in West Kalimantan, East Kalimantan, Central Sulawesi, and Maluku. 2 of 4 results of studies had been published in form of position paper.
- 2.2. Participatory mapping result packing. Documentation of success stories on participatory mapping had been available in form of writings and multimedia, though they were not thorough enough.
- 2.3. Encouraging policy changes. JKPP Secretariat cooperated with its members had held 11 times of dialogue activities on policy at regional level with various spatial issues, like mining, forestry community, traditional community rights, draft of regulations submission, conflict resolution among villages, and so on. Recalling that the participatory mapping is a crosscutting issue, JKPP broadly cooperated with networks like KPA, JATAM, KpSHK, and WALHI.
- 2.4. Network development. This program mandated the scaling up of fund access and credibility of JKPP to funding agencies and the promotion of PARTICIPATORY MAPPING to AMAN and other people organization. The fund raising efforts had been seriously conducted, although in reality they still could not support the entire activities planned by JKPP.

3. Information Management

Participatory Mapping Information Service. This program mandated the setting of database for participatory mapping coverage, the creating and maintaining of JKPP website, and the maintaining of communication and various publishing activities with spatial issues. JKPP website (www.jkpp.org) had been updated in 2005.
