11:00-13:15	PLENARY 1: Land Governance, Equity and Sustainability in Albania and the Balkans  After the collapse of the socialist system Albania went through radical political and economic transformations, paving the way for a transition from a planned, centrally driven economy to a market economy. In the last two decades some progress has been made regarding land reforms and private ownership transfers.  The privatisation of agricultural land has been the most crucial component of mass privatisation in Albania, directly impacting the country's economic growth and the property rights of landowners. In other countries in the Balkans region many crucial factors, conflicts among them, have determined new contexts for natural resource management and communities in rural areas.
